



To complete a Hockey Australia Level 1 Coach Accreditation, please contact your local centre/association Regional Coaching Director or Course Presenter to confirm your interest in enrolling into the next full day course program being held by email or telephone to reserve your place.

Please note that any course fees set by the local centre/association to cover costs of the one day program, are payable to said local centre/association.

Before you attend the one day Level 1 Program, the following steps need to be completed

- 1. Go to the Level 1 Coach Accreditation page at Hockey Australia, register as a Level 1 Coach and you will need to pay \$40 Coach Registration Fee (\$40 = 4 year accreditation)

- 2. You will then receive a confirmation email from Hockey Australia with your unique login and password details from the Moodle System, please save these details to enable you to return to Hockey Ed at any time
- 3. Complete the Hockey Ed Level 1 online coaching modules and once completed, print/screenshot to show proof of completion
- 4. Go to https://learning.ausport.gov.au/Auth/Login?ReturnUrl=%2f# and register, enrol and complete the Community Coaching Principles Certificate
- 5. Once complete, print/screenshot an image of the ASC Community Coaching Principles Certificate

Either e-mail to the course presenter or print out and bring along with you the two pieces of certification of online courses completed to the Level 1 Course.

Complete the theory and practical learning modules at the Level 1 course

Get assessed / arrange a practical assessment with the course presenter.

When all of the above steps have been followed, this completes all requirements of the Hockey Australia Level 1 Coaching Accreditation process.

Your course presenter will then provide you with feedback and all of accreditation documentation will be forwarded to Hockey Queensland to be finalised. When processed, you will receive an accreditation certificate by email from Hockey Australia.
