- All applications attract a fee. The total fee should be paid at registration or the \$50 deposit for Club Membership paid with completed registration form and the 100% remaining balance to be paid by the first playing date. Alternatively, an application for a payment plan must be made in writing and submitted to the Club Treasurer. Unfinancial members will not be permitted to play until such time as they become financial.
- Conditions governing inter-district or inter-club clearance requirements must comply with the constitution of the South Perth Baseball Club Inc. and Baseball WA.
- On payment of fees, the Club will issue a uniform playing shirt. The player agrees to keep the uniform clean and serviceable at all times and to return the uniform in good order at the conclusion of the season, or at any time upon demand by a Club elected Officer or Committee member. Non-return or damage will incur a penalty equal to the cost of repair or replacement of the uniform.
- The umpiring of at home games conducted by the Junior Division, as well as Canteen Duty is compulsory for all players. No playing member is permitted to declare him or herself unavailable for umpiring and canteen beyond one opportunity during the season.
- Members, on payment of their fees, will be covered by BWA's insurance, applicable to registered players and the Club's insurance. As these policies generally do not cover minor personal injuries that may be incurred during training or playing, members are advised to take out private medical and accident insurance to cover personal accident, medical and/or weekly benefits. Ambulance cover is also advisable.
- If applying member withdraws before the first playing date, he/she will receive a full refund. If the player withdraws after that date, no refund will be given. All requests for refunds must be made in writing to the Committee.
- Whilst on Club premises, the member shall agree to show and display good conduct during practice and BWA fixture games. He/she shall demonstrate support of the Club, its sponsors and the sport of baseball.
- The player member, in joining South Perth Baseball Club Inc. agrees to play by the rules laid down by BWA, and in force or as amended from time to time during the period of the Registration & Contract Agreement, which shall be for the duration of the
