TERMS & CONDITION OF MEMBERSHIP

Junior Parent Code of behaviour

1. Children play baseball for FUN. Accept any mistakes as part of their learning process. Remember they are playing for their enjoyment not yours.
2. Don't leave your child/children at Baseball, stay and support the team, volunteer to help and discuss your child's progress with the coach.
3. Applaud good play from both teams and encourage your child/children to accept that honest effort is as important as victory.
4. Encourage your child/children to always play within the rules of Baseball and accept the umpire's decision.
5. Never ridicule, abuse or yell at a child for making a mistake or losing a game.
6. Offensive behaviour from parents or spectators is not acceptable under the rules of Baseball and stern action will be taken against offenders.
7. Recognise the value and importance of the volunteer coaches and officials. They give of their time and knowledge to provide organised Baseball for your child and deserve your respect and support.
8. Baseball is a team game. Accept and understand that at times your child may be asked to take a turn on the bench.
9. Not all children can be champions. Do not force an unwilling child to participate in Baseball or expect more from them than their best efforts.
10. If you disagree with an official or coach, raise the issue through the appropriate channels rather than question the person in public.
11. Foul language of any sort will not be tolerated
12. Show support for our "Together Against Drug's" policy.
13. As a duty of care a Tee Ball, Machine Pitch, LL or JL parent or guardian is encouraged to remain at the ground during training and game days.
14. Encourage your child/children to read the Parents Code of Behaviour and Players Code of Behaviour.

Junior Player Code of Behaviour

1. Learn the rules of Baseball and always play by them
2. All athletes or officials shall agree not to use banned substances or procedures for any purpose. This includes social substances.
3. Never argue with an umpire, opposition umpire or official. If you have a problem, discuss it with your coach and allow him to take necessary action.
4. Your coach or umpires will not tolerate verbal abuse of, or deliberate physical interference, with opponents.
5. Strive to play to the best of your ability at all times, both at practice and during the games.
6. Respect the time and efforts put in by your coaches and officials. They deserve your support and full commitment.
7. Baseball is a team game. Encourage your teammates, even when they make mistakes. Remember every player makes errors and has off days. Never ridicule opponents or teammates.
8. Respect your opponents and appreciate their good play. Without opposition you would not be able to play the game of Baseball.
9. Accept that at times you may be required to take a turn on the bench. When on the bench encourage your team and be prepared to play at all times.
10. Play to enjoy the game and improve your baseball skills.
11. Respect the equipment provided for your use. Baseball equipment is very expensive and should be used responsibly. Abuse of equipment such as throwing helmets or bats will not be tolerated.
12. Always think safety to avoid injury to yourself and others.
13. Foul language of any sort will not be tolerated.
14. Dress and act like a baseballer at all times. Remember you are all ambassadors for our sport.
15. Remember: **NO BOX, NO PLAY.** Mouth guards are optional.

I confirm the player is in adequate physical condition and free of illness or other medical problems to allow the player to safely participate in the sport of baseball. I hereby release the South Perth Baseball Club Inc. (the "Club" and all of its coaches, staff, committee members, members, and any employees or subcontractors) from any and all liability for injury or medical problems incurred by he player while attending and participating in activities run by the Club. I further agree to defend, indemnify and hold harmless the Club, its affiliates and their respective Officers, Committee Members, Coaches, Members, Employees and agents from and against all claims and expenses, including legal fees, arising out of the player's participation in activities run by the Club.

PLAYER INSURANCE

Part of a Players' fee structure includes the Baseball WA annual registration and insurance fee, which must be collected by the Club and also covers players for sanctioned Baseball games and Club activities for the season.
