"EXPECTATIONS"

Umpires are not unlike most sportsmen, they want to succeed and reach the pinnacle in their chosen sport of Umpiring.

Since the start of the 1987 Football season I have written about a lot of things including pre-season training "Pressures of umpiring" and fitness. In this issue we will look at the "will to succeed".

Most umpires start their apprenticeship in the Junior games doing under 10's and 12's and U14's, if they are lucky enough to survive this and if they are good enough they will go on to Umpire U16 and U18's. I say survive because we loose a lot of Umpires whilst in the Juniors, mainly because of unwarranted abuse from spectators and parents alike. When an umpire walks off the ground at the end of the game which has more than likely been played in knee deep mud and it has been pouring with rain, and some person gives him a mouth full of abuse because their team did not win, he tends to think just what is umpiring all about and perhaps he could do without a verbal bashing from the mouths of an ignorant few.

When you have completed your apprenticeship and you are an accomplished umpire, the Umpire's Board may appoint you to a seconds game. This is very hard and tough football, because most of the players are trying very hard to impress and get into the firsts. The umpire officiates at these games one out-no goal or boundary umpires can be supplied due to a shortage of umpires. After both sides have run you ragged and you are sitting in the umpires room, all alone, very tired and probably covered in mud, its nice to have the delegates from both clubs knock on your door and say to you "Good job ump" and invite you back into the Clubrooms for a friendly taste.

Once again when the Umpire's Board considers you are good enough you will get promoted into the "Senior Panel". This is great as you will have a full crew with you, and they help and support each other with an encouraging word during the breaks. However its up here where the heat is really turned up, with young up-and-coming umpires putting the pressures on from below, and from above is the "Observer", he is out there writing down your good and bad points, which in the end helps you become a better umpire.

So next time you feel like tipping a bucket of worms over the Umpire officiating at a junior game or any other game for that matter, just think a kind word like "well done ump", may keep him going. One day in the future he might go on and umpire Senior football, and don't forget there's never been too many umpires. We need them!
