Ellen has been a member and Chair of the NSW Snowboarding Committee for 6 years and was instrumental in the establishment of the Australian Junior Series, Australia's premier freestyle snowboarding series. Ellen and her husband Stuart were also responsible for establishing the Australian Rookie Fest in Australia and with the NSW Snowboarding Committee have made that event a successful stop on the World Snowboard Tour. Ellen also contributes to policy development at the national level.

Ellen has two snowboarders in the family, Pat Davis-Meehan who spent three years on the NSWIS HP team and Michaela Davis-Meehan, currently a member of the Australian SS team and competing on the World Cup tour and seeking Olympic selection.
