Squash (male and female)

Laws of the Game: Squash

The World Squash Singles Laws of the Game are followed for SUSF Lunchtime Social Squash Competitions. These rules can be found by visiting this [link](#).

SUSF Lunchtime Social Sport Modifications

There are two separate competitions for female and male players.

Scoring

- The server is decided by a racket spin or coin toss.
- The winner of a rally scores 1 point and serves to begin the next rally.
- Each game is played to 11 points, except that if the score reaches 10-all, the game continues until one player leads by 2 points.
- A match is complete after 3 games have been played or 28 minutes has passed, whichever comes first

Team Size

- All players must be registered and ONLY registered players may play.

Match Duration

- Matches consist of 3 games of squash or 28 minutes of time - a running clock will start at the scheduled time of the game.

Stoppages and Blood Rule

- When a player is injured or ill, stoppage of up to 2 minutes is allowed.
- Any player with visible blood or bleeding on their clothing or person must be removed from the game and may not return until all bleeding has stopped.

Referees

- These games will be self-refereed.



Misconduct

- The use of Yellow and Red Cards is at the discretion of the referee
- Their decision is final and cannot be overturned
- If a player is shown a yellow card, they must leave the field for a period of TWO minutes.
 - The player (or a team mate) may return to the playing area after the two minutes is complete.
 - If a player is shown a red card, they must leave the field for the remaining duration of the match.

Finals

- After all normal rounds of games are played, the top 4 teams according to overall Ladder board will proceed through to play a single elimination tournament to decide which team is the overall winner of the Squash competition.

Any abuse or gross misconduct directed at referees or other players will result in exclusion from the game, possible suspension for the individual and/or team.
