Zone

- Zone meeting summary previously provided by Alison Kniha:
- More people will need to become qualified as officials for future regional carnivals, especially 'B' grade officials.

- All zone cheques are now banked.
- Athlete certificates from the zone championships have been printed and will be coming to the centre for distribution soon. All the results and reports have already been sent to centres.
- Springwood achieved 8 new zone records certificates were given to Janie.
- Springwood to host the zone next year. Timed program to remain for now.
- Will need to ensure at least 3 track umpires for future carnivals as a result of controversy at last carnival.
- Regional carnival first call at 7.45am both days.
- Need to handover the cheque at the carnival to take delivery of the programs (SDAC \$207).
- First four in each event to State, then the next 6 'best' from all regions to make a total of 24 athletes for each event. The 'next best' will be listed on the LANSW website.
- State helpers will be required for 2 hours at a time due to the larger number of athletes in each event. Extra helpers will be required as two tracks will be running. ALL parents will be required to help at State (I suggest we send out individual letters to qualifying athletes families with this requirement spelt out I am happy to write and send these for discussion at the next meeting).
- The Lithgow Flash Carnival is now a whole day carnival starting at 8am with markets then events for all ages. Entries open now.
- Annual Conference to be held in Ulladulla in July each centre must seriously consider sending a representative to this conference. Club to discuss sponsoring someone to go.
- The official zone coordinator election is in a month if anyone wants to nominate to run against Matt Andrews who is acting at the moment, see Janie or myself for a nomination form. Votes will be held on a number of other matters at the same time e.g. transfer of records and finances to the new zone (which commences 1 April).
- The zone committee will be directly appointed unless more than one person nominates for a particular position, in which case there will be a vote.
- The meetings for the new zone will begin in April, with the following one held in early July at Springwood Sports Club. Will eventually hold one at Lithgow. Teleconferencing is an option.
- Matt was to visit the Mudgee and Kandos clubs over the weekend to attend their comp days (if they were not washed out!).
- Glen Taylor has nominated for the Regional Coordinator position.
- The first regional carnival for the new region will most likely be the second weekend in February, in either Dubbo or Bathurst. The only options for holding Regionals are:
- 1. Dubbo, or
- 2. Orange / Bathurst, or
- 3. Lithgow / Blacktown
