



Expressions of Interest - 15U National Team Staff Positions

Baseball Australia is currently seeking expressions of interest for two coaching positions available on the Australian 15U National Team coaching staff. Joining Team Manager – Andrew Kyle, Assistant Coach - Tyrone Hambly and Executive Officer Neil Barrowcliff, these positions are designed to assist the team maximise performance outcomes at the 2018 15U World Cup to be held in Panama in August.

The two coaching positions are as follows;

- Assistant Coach
- Pitching Coach

These are volunteer positions with travel, accommodation and associated costs covered. Candidates must be available for the following programs;

1. 15U Selection Camp – Sydney NSW – 1st – 6th July 2018
2. World Cup training camp and WBSC 15U World Cup – 3rd–19th August 2018

Applicants for these positions should possess;

- Experience in coaching at a high level of baseball
- Experience and knowledge of international baseball
- An understanding of the demands of tournament baseball and high-performance sport
- A willingness to work with current staff and be a contributor to the desired performance outcomes of the team
- Pitching coach should have an understanding of workload management and be able to manage a pitching staff appropriately against the WBSC tournament pitching norms

Interested applicants should submit the following information to Baseball Australia for consideration;

1. Cover letter outlining reasons why you believe to be the right candidate for a coaching role with the 15U National Team (no more than 2 pages)
2. Resume outlining your experience in baseball (no more than 5 pages)

Applications should be submitted to employment@baseball.org.au by 5pm Friday 8th of June. All applications will be reviewed after this date and candidates will be considered and assessed for suitability in order to fill these roles.
