## 0402. Word Interpretation

The following words have been defined to mean;

1. **Bow Type** The bow to be used by the archer, e.g. Compound, Recurve, Longbow.
2. **Division** The division an archer competes in e.g.; 11 and Under, Cub, Open, Veteran, etc.
3. **Sex** Male or Female
4. **Category** The combination of the 3 sections above. Barebow Recurve (bow type), Cadet (division), Male (sex) is the BCM category.
5. **Class** The class within the division, e.g.; 3rd Class, 1st Class, Master Bowmen.
6. **Disciplines** The type of activity to be undertaken, e.g. Outdoor Target, Indoor Target, Field, Clout.
7. **Round** The round to be shot, e.g. Canberra, FITA, Fremantle.
8. **Event** One or more rounds, e.g. Canberra, FITA, Fremantle.
9. **End** A bracket of arrows shot in an archery round or event.
10. **Range** A bracket of five or six ends, depending on the round being shot.
11. **Shall-Must** Compulsory.
12. **Should** Suggestion/recommendation.
13. **Clear Copy** A copy, either photocopies or scanned and noted in original handwriting by the Club representative as such.
14. **Championship** An organised Archery Victoria event, organised by Officials of Archery Victoria.
15. **Tournament** An organised Archery Victoria event, organised by Officials of Archery Victoria.
16. **QRE** An organised Archery Australia event, coordinated by Officials of Archery Australia.
