## **0410. Dress Code**

### **1. Dress Code**

- 1.1. Clubs may set their own dress code. However, clubs must register their dress code or uniform with the Chief Executive Officer. Refer to Policy 0406 Club Code.
- 1.2. Changes to a clubs dress code must be communicated to the Chief Executive Officer within 21 days of the change.

### **2. State and Calendar Tournaments**

- 2.1. Archers attending State or Calendar Tournament are expected to wear archery uniform, defined as any archery related top with club lower garments or neat casual lower garments.
- 2.2. Hats and shoes must be neat.
- 2.3. Shoes must have closed toe.
- 2.4. All white may be worn at any time.

### **3. National Tournaments**

- 3.1. Archers attending National tournaments must wear similar dress to that of State and Calendar Tournaments.
- 3.2. State Team Members must wear the Archery Victoria Shirt with Lower Garments as set out in the Youth and Senior Development booklet.

### **4. Definition, Archery top.**

Archery Top is any top relating to archery such as;

- 4.1. Club top.
- 4.2. Tournament top.
- 4.3. State top.
- 4.4. Archery Sponsors top.
- 4.5. National uniform top.
- 4.6. Archery Representative top.

**5. Other**

5.1. Inclement weather clothing may be worn as necessary.

5.2. No camouflage clothing (including tops and pants) are allowed under any circumstances.
