## 0420. Age Divisions

### 1. General

- 1.1. Archery Victoria shall support the age divisions as listed by Archery Australia.
- 1.2. Archery Victoria will encourage our younger archers by providing an additional division for those 11 years of age and younger.

Division	Years Of Birth
<b>Joey</b>	An athlete may compete in the Joey division until December 31 <sup>st</sup> of the year of their 11 <sup>th</sup> birthday.  May also be referred to as Joey 11 and Under.
<b>Cub</b>	An athlete may compete in the Cub division until December 31 <sup>st</sup> of the year of their 13 <sup>th</sup> birthday.  May also be referred to as Cub 13 and Under.
<b>Intermediate</b>	An athlete may compete in the Intermediate division until December 31 <sup>st</sup> of the year of their 15 <sup>th</sup> birthday.  May also be referred to as Intermediate 15 and Under.
<b>Cadet</b>	An athlete may compete in the Cadet division until December 31 <sup>st</sup> of the year of their 17 <sup>th</sup> birthday.  May also be referred to as Cadet 17 and Under.
<b>Junior</b>	An athlete may compete in the Junior division until December 31 <sup>st</sup> of the year of their 20 <sup>th</sup> birthday.  May also be referred to as Junior 20 and Under.
<b>Open</b>	An athlete of any age may compete in the Open division.
<b>Master</b>	An athlete may compete in the Master division from January 1 <sup>st</sup> of the year of their 50 <sup>th</sup> birthday and thereafter.
<b>Veteran</b>	An athlete may compete in the Veteran division from January 1 <sup>st</sup> of the year of their 60 <sup>th</sup> birthday and thereafter.
