

How to Register

The registration process for 2019 is similar to last year, but there are two key changes: a new Sportstg database platform called GameDay is being used, so it'll look a bit different, and the Hockey SA registration fee is now split into the Hockey SA and Hockey Australia components. Registration still requires 2 separate steps:

- Entry into GameDay of player details and payment of Hockey Australia / Hockey SA fees.
- Payment of club fees via the Adelaide Hockey Club website

Because of the new GameDay platform, you will be asked to set up a new login account with Hockey Australia.

For a basic description of how to register:

1. Go to the [Hockey SA website](#) and click on the 2019 Online Registration box.
2. Select Hockey SA Metropolitan Competition and then Adelaide Hockey Club.
3. A Hockey Australia login page will appear. Unless you have already done so, set up a new account by clicking on "Don't have an account?". You can use the same email and login you used in 2018, or set up a new account from scratch.
4. Once you have a Hockey Australia account, login to it.
5. Fill out the form that appears, answering the questions and selecting the registration items required. You can backtrack if you need to correct anything. Once you have registered one person, you can add another person from the Summary page. Payment by credit card or PayPal is required.
6. You will receive an email from Sportstg entitled "Successful Registration for Adelaide Hockey Club", which will direct you to the Adelaide Hockey Club website for club fee payment. Payment by credit/debit card is required.
7. Go to the Adelaide Hockey Club payment page ([Registration/Make an Online Payment](#)), select the items as per your registration and pay for them.

Please note that the club has a strict "no pay: no play" policy and all fees are payable before you take the field.
