He shot a 539 with for his Darwin score, beating his previous rating of 25 by 5 points, resulting in an adjusted score of 958/900 and taking his rating up to 27. Vinh Ha came in second with with a 634, translating into an adjusted score of 910/900. Antony Wijesinghe brought in third place, raising his rating from 89 to 90, having shot a score of 869. Great shooting, everyone!
