FINANCIAL

- ◆ P&L covering the first eight months of our 2013/14 financial year shows a loss of \$28,848 which is \$16,416 less than for the same period last year (i.e. loss of \$45,264 which also included net proceeds of \$34,667 for sale of four gaming machine licences).
- ◆ YTD Profit before allowing for depreciation is \$24,864.
- ◆ Total current assets of \$245,827 (including cash assets \$210,221) shows our reasonably sound financial position at date.

HOUSE

- ◆ Gaming Machine Net Clearances are **up** by \$27,842 (28%) with turnover increasing by \$319,116 over the corresponding period last year.
- ◆ Numbers attending on Friday nights have noticeably improved this year, a pleasing trend that we need to continue into 2014.
