


## The latest from our PL Zuluettes.

**What are some interesting facts/hobbies/info about yourself?**


I have 2 sisters and a brother. I got both my parents and sisters into playing hockey.


**What is your favourite sport besides hockey?** Basketball. I am a huge NBA and LeBron James fan.
