CHRISTMAS IN JULY

More than 110 people enjoyed a great three course dinner on Saturday 19th July.

The auditorium looked great all dressed up in red and green.

Everyone thoroughly enjoyed Shaun Martindale's entertainment and many were still bopping on the dance floor well after 11.00pm.

Thank you to all who helped set up for the night and as usual our kitchen staff of Sherry and Ging led by Anna did a sterling job.

I only crossed paths with Carl once, but it was on an auspicious occasion for him.

The event at which we met was held at The Australian Maritime Museum just after Australia's Bicentenary in 1988.

I was a manager in a large Norwegian shipping company. Our Chief Executive was also the Honorary Consul General for Norway. As a consequence of that, we managers were often involved with the Norwegian community, celebrating Norway's National Day and so on. This was one such event.

In the years and months leading up to Australia's Bicentenary, the nations of the world had been casting around in search of suitable presents for them to give to Australia. Norway found an old hulk on a beach in Guam and looked into her provenance. It was discovered that the lady had quite a history. She had started life as the "Kathleen Gillett".

This famous double ended ketch had been built in Sydney in 1939 for a marine artist named Jack Earl (1908 – 1994) and had been named after his wife. They lived on board. Jack organised the first Sydney Hobart race in 1945 and she participated. In June 1947 Jack and crew set sail to circumnavigate the world in Kathleen, the second Australian yacht to complete this feat. He created the most wonderful illuminated logbook covering the voyage.

Jack sold her in the 1950s and she then had an interesting career which included island trading, crocodile hunting and copra lugger. Then she ended up on the Guam beach.

Norway arranged to ship her back to Sydney and asked Carl and his colleagues to completely refurbish her. It was a big job. It was eventually completed and she was taken to the finger pier at The Australian National Maritime Museum in Darling Harbour. She was in perfect condition by that time.

We were all assembled on the finger pier. Kathleen Gillett was to the right, far below wharf deck level. On the left loomed the large Daring Class destroyer HMAS Vampire.

Rear Admiral Peter Sinclair, NSW Governor, made the presentation and as a part of that indicated that he'd been around the world in that, pointing up at the destroyer but would think twice about trying it in that, pointing down to the ketch. Then we all repaired to the museum for a celebratory lunch.

Carl was surprised to find himself invited to the podium and was thereupon presented with a medal and a citation. The presentation was made by the Norwegian Minister for Education and Science. He had been made a Knight First Class of the Royal Order of Merit – the highest honour the King of Norway can bestow. The room rang with applause.

Well done Carl, and Vale!
