- 1. Learn the rules of Baseball and always play by them.

- 6. Respect the time and efforts put in by your coaches and officials. They deserve your support and full commitment.
- 7. Baseball is a team game. Encourage your teammates, even when they make mistakes. Remember every player makes errors and has off days. Never ridicule opponents or teammates.
- 8. Respect your opponents and appreciate their good play. Without opposition you would not be able to play the game of Baseball.
- 9. Accept that at times you may be required to take a turn on the bench. When on the bench encourage your team and be prepared to play at all times.
- 10. Play to enjoy the game and improve your baseball skills.
- 11. Respect the equipment provided for your use. Baseball equipment is very expensive and should be used responsibly. Abuse of equipment such as throwing helmets or bats will not be tolerated.
- 12. Always think safety to avoid injury to yourself and others.
- 13. Foul language of any sort will not be tolerated.
