0492. Recognition of Achievement

Archery Victoria (AV) promotes and supports archers in reaching the highest levels of competition, which is to represent Australia in international championship events.

Awards in the form of financial support are provided to those archers who win a place and compete on a national team for the events defined below.

1. Defined Events

The following are eligible events for Recognition of Achievement awards:

- 1.1. Olympic Games
- 1.2. Commonwealth Games
- 1.3. World Target Championships
- 1.4. World Youth Target Championships
- 1.5. World Field Championships
- 1.6. World Cups

2. Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible for an Award an archer must:

- 2.1. Have their primary membership with an AV club
- 2.2. Win selection on an Australian national team through a competitive selection process and the achievement of a high level minimum qualifying score.
- 2.3. Attend and compete in the event.
- 2.4. Archers who gain membership of teams by filling a vacancy only without being selected on merit are NOT eligible.

3. Support Provided

- 3.1. The sum of \$500 will be provided to the archer upon receipt of their application following the event.
- 3.2. Only one award per calendar year may be claimed by a given archer.

4. Application Requirements

- 4.1. Archers must submit all documents to support their Application for Archery Victoria's Achievement Award.
- 4.2. This application will include:
 - 4.2.1. Letter of offer from Archery Australia to be a member of the national team.
 - 4.2.2. Copy of the official Archery Australia team selection procedure for the event.
 - 4.2.3. Details of qualifying scores shot, rankings achieved etc. to satisfy the requirements of the AA team selection. ,
 - 4.2.4. Evidence that the archer did compete in the event (typically official competition results).
