PRESIDENT'S REPORT

I am delighted to present the Bowls North (Inc.) Annual Report. After six years as Chairman, it's time for me to step down, allowing for new blood and new leadership of our Association.

I will take this opportunity to thank all members and in particular Board Members who have worked with me through the six years; at times we have pushed aside the ways of the past in an attempt to make our Association relevant to modern times and thinking. It has not been easy and indeed comfortable for many but I firmly believe we have achieved an enormous amount in that time.

In particular, I must mention the transition to open-gender bowls in our region.

Saturday pennant has consolidated.

But, at the time of writing this report, Thursday pennant, and its current playing conditions, is under review by the Tasmanian Anti-Discrimination Commissioner. At the most recent Presidents and Secretaries forum, it was generally agreed to leave the COP as they are for another year.

Notwithstanding, should the Commissioner rule against us, the COP will have to be changed. That will be a challenge for the new Board.

Constitution

Your Board has recognised that minor amendments need to be made to the Constitution to keep it relevant to today's times.

Amendments recommended are to formally recognise Bowls Tasmania as the governing body of bowls in this State; to establish an independent tribunal and to do away with the role of Club Delegates.

Presidents and Secretaries are clearly the representatives of their clubs and are in the best position to advise Bowls North on its current and future direction.

I would like to publicly recognise Rae & Partners, our honorary legal firm, for the invaluable assistance afforded us in revising the constitution. In particular, I want to thank our Honorary Legal Advisor Kate Walker for her help. Due to her maternity leave from the firm, her input was picked up by Casandra Blair. Jo Simms, our own Michael Sims' mum, is also recognised for her assistance in all matters legal.

Retirement

You will be aware that our Vice-President Margaret Pearce is joining me in 'retirement'. Margaret has been a fabulous deputy and confident of mine and I really appreciate her support and friendship over the years. Thank you Margaret for what you have put into this great game over the years, both administratively and of course, as an absolute champion on the green. Bowls North will miss you.

Pennant

On the greens, it was East Launceston which collected the prized Saturday Pennant Mitsubishi Premier League Trophy in a most emphatic manner. The club also collected the prized Division One trophy, emphasising the strength and depth of players at East.

The Thursday Division One pennant went to Invermay in what was another outstanding performance. The 'Swampies', led by our Australian representative Rebecca Van Asch, thoroughly deserved their history making victory over the very strong Kings Meadows combination.

We congratulate all other pennant winners, both Saturday and Thursday. Special congratulations to our State Pennant winners Invermay and Cosgrove Park (Thursday) and Westbury (Saturday).

Four of our men represented our State during the year and four women also achieved the highest accolade afforded to our players.

Congratulations to Mark Strochnetter who has played his 300th game representing Bowls Tasmania a fantastic achievement. Well done Mark.

Congratulations also to our Bowls North champions – Michael Sims (men) and Kim Saunders (women). I had the pleasure of 'marking' both men's and women's finals this year, which I regard as an honour.

Match Committee

I publicly commend the Match Committee on their work during the season, and am often amazed at how they fit such a full program of events into the calendar each year. It's a job that does not get any easier. I make particular reference to Warren Groves, the Match Committee Chairman, for the work he does for the committee.

Selectors, Statistician, Publicity.

Our selectors are thanked and congratulated on their work. We had a combined meeting of all selectors, men, women and juniors, during the season to discuss issues affecting them. A report was prepared from that meeting and forwarded to Bowls Tasmania for comment.

Our Statistician, Sue Ross is to be commended for her statistical work throughout the season. Sue has indicated that she is stepping down from this important role. Her contribution has been exceptional and to find a replacement for her is going to be very difficult! Thank you Sue.

Our Publicity Officers, Lyn Mitchell and Greg Baker continue to keep everyone informed through their Examiner columns. I understand the frustration of the men's lower divisions in a lack of publicity but assure you that it is not Greg's fault!

Facebook administrator, Natalie Hill stepped up to take on this role and has done so with great enthusiasm.

Umpires

Led by retiring Director Les Harrison, our umpires deserve more thanks than what they get, so I take this opportunity to congratulate and thank them on your behalf. Many of them sit through a full day's play with nothing more than their love of the game keeping them there. That we were able this year to compensate them in some small way was comforting. I trust this initiative will continue into the future.

Youth Development

One area I specifically want to mention is that of youth development.

David Simms and his team of Dennis Page and Mick Oliver have taken our Youth Development program to a new high. Our youth won everything put in front of them this year, which effectively means our future players are well coached, well-disciplined and well set for things to come.

As this is my last report, it would be remiss of me not to thank most sincerely our Association Secretary Gaylene McNab. Gaylene has been my confidant, advisor, supporter and totally respected friend during my years on the Board. To be frank, I could not have done the job without her help.

She is an incredibly valued member of the team and has undertaken her very difficult job with thorough professionalism. Her roles have expanded considerably, but nothing seems to faze her! Her support to me as President has been fabulous and I wish to thank her, and husband John, most sincerely.

East Coast Association

We met with the East Coast Association during the year with a view to bringing them under our wing administratively. Ongoing discussions are progressing. We see the proposal as a means to assist them to run their pennant competition and championships and as a way to provide their youth with a developmental path into regional and ultimately, state representation which is not currently available. 
