ISCH Board via Garry Bull (President ISCH Board) asked if the ISCH Officiating Committee could in conjunction with Field Competition Committee act as Judiciary committee for the completion of the 2015 season, and asked if I could Chair the judiciary.
7. **LETTER FROM UNIVERSITY HOCKEY CLUB**
Letter from University Hockey Club was table about behaviour of club from Dapto Hockey Club – dissent to appointed umpire and harassment to players from sideline – discussion took place about overall conduct of all clubs and clubs need to look after their own - Committee given all players, coaches, officials and

spectators general warning if you persist you will face ISCH Officiating Committee about conduct or passed on Board or Judiciary Committee.

8. CODE OF CONDUCT

Committee wishes that number of point around the stadium and complex have a copies of all codes of conduct and as soon as possible each individual player, coach, manager and officials sign these and be hold at the centre for use by judiciary committee it need,

Need to look at possible ground manager or even duty officers for Lindsay Mayne Hockey Complex, Croome Road and University.

9. UMPIRE LISTS FROM COMPETITIONS

Discussion took place over appointments of officials across ISCH and if enough officials could be sort the ISCH OC would appoint all grades umpires and technical officials. Attention is need to have a senior umpire coach panel available as soon as possible – Target 2016

Need to get a minimum of three quote and go to FHE for their quote – also need to look at gender shirts.

- ✚ Officiating Coordinator to contact each competition committee and ask for mouth guard waiver list as soon as possible.
- ✚ Technical Officials to check players before going on field and if umpire sees player with NO MOUTH GUARD – GREEN CARD to be given.
- ✚ Technical Officials to check off each player very carefully please.

13. UMPIRE DEVELOPMENT – UMPIRE WORKBOOKS

Discussion took place about the use of workbook and why these are necessary to assist all umpires. Look into cost of workbooks or even developing ISCH books.
ISCH OC look at possible use of new umpire accreditation guidelines and inner action with Hockey ED - would like indorsed HQ accreditation guidelines and it be sent off to HNSW.

14. JUNIOR DEVELOPMENT FORUM

ISCH Junior field competition committee have set up a Junior umpire Development forum for 13th July 5.30pm at Lindsay Mayne Hockey Stadium meeting room.

Look at developing Minkies rules (Minimum to the Hin2H and Minkie) – dangerous play – back of stick and ball on the foot
