8 DISCUSSION ON 2016 COMPETITION FORMAT FOLLOWING PRELIMINARY NOMINATIONS UNDER 18 WOMEN'S AND JUNIORS FINAL TEAM NUMBERS

COMPETITIONS IN 2016

- o Firstly teams nominated for 2015 Under 18 Girls stated that platers did not wish to play in 2016
- Question asked by chair, would there be enough player to run a gender based Under 18 competitions, after a discussion clubs said not enough players to run these competitions
- UNi (PP) stated it is poor position that we cannot run two competitions in this age group and that no girls wish to play.
- WEST (WJ) also stated they have only 7 girls wishing to play
- 3 Nominations for girls competition at that times NO competition will be run 2016, Wes asked to keep final decision until next meeting (DF) to contact clubs not attending to see if another team can be put together.
- Girls wish to play in Junior Under 18 competition, number of club still said that some girls do not wish to play in a mixed gender competition.

- Chairpersons (DF) asked if clubs wish to cancel Under 18 Competition in 2016 and majority of the clubs vote yes.
- UNI (PP) asked if we could possible to look at short games for under 18 girls, Chairperson (DF) remaindered the club that they previously stated not enough numbers.
- Gerringong inquired about looking at age group gender competitions, from passed information
 Avondale would be in favour of Under 13 age group After discussion on topic NO fixed commitment
 was made by JFCC on this matter

8.1 SPORTS IN SCHOOLS

- Dapto (JH) stated that there is NO hockey in schools until terms 3 & 4 in 2016, Wes comment that yes this is so but when 2017 comes around be ready for the influx of young players, especially that this is an Olympic year. Need to cash in on that in 2017.
- Wes also informed the meeting that in term 4 had three schools attend a day in December with 7 club members assisting Barry Reid and gave out information to each person that attend skill based sessions.
- Barry Reid has attend regional school council meeting to push for hockey in a full sport in schools programs – Wes informed meeting that HNSW RCC will not be able to do this on their own. ISC Development committee will need to have a plan in please to support program, information need for clubs.
- o Hockey NSW has committed to Schools in sport program for 2016 and forward.
- Danielle Ford Sport in School Hockey Coach stated that the program has visited three schools in 2015 – there is funds (grants) out there for coaches to use in school sport programs, Albion Park (JM) asked could these funds be made available for a bus and turf hire (YES) Danielle - meeting with Stanmore Park setting program for this year and also Alex Mackay working wish Ben Senior in this program

8.2 UNDER 18 GIRLS COMPETITION

- UNI (PP) we need further discussion on this matter, after a lengthy and clubs, vote in majority to have a carnival on the 16th March (Both genders 9 a side)
- (WJ) made a statement that we cannot have a gender based competition until we give the players a taste of in it. Nomination for all clubs needs to be in by 2:00 pm 9th March 2016.
- Adjustments made to the 2016 plan for Under 18 junior competition on the 16th March, double header will be played early in season.
- Also noted that there will be 8:30pm match each round of Under 18 juniors comp.

8.3 SPLITTING OF AGE GROUPS

- o That each age group would be split into an A Division & B Division (10 teams 6 − 4 back down? 9 teams 5 − 4 break down)
- This will take place in all age group after round 9
