I've really been gunning for Dubai World Championship, and I don't want to commentate there. I'll gladly do it if I have to, but yeah, just be the wrong side of the ropes. Living just down the road, it's been rubbish the last few years. Still a bit of work to do to finish the job off but it's good fun trying, as well.

Q. Plenty of positives to take from the way you played?

DAVID HOWELL: Absolutely. I played really nice again this week, and so difficult out there with the greens so firm and fast. It's pretty nerve-wracking knocking the short ones in, and the only one I missed really was 17, just didn't get down the hill.

But a lovely 2-putt at the last would have been nice if it had gone in obviously. But funny enough my caddie said, you haven't had a real long one all week. I thought he was talking nonsense, but as it turns out, it was half a roll from being right. But a great finish.
