Classifications for V.I. Archery cover:

- **B1 – No light perception in either eye, up to light perception in either or both eyes, but inability to recognise the shape of a hand at any distance.**
- **B2 – Visual acuity ONLY - From ability to recognise the shape of a hand up to 2/60.**
- **B3 – Visual acuity ONLY - From 2/60 up to 6/60.**
- **VI Open – Visual Fields ONLY – Not more than 20 degrees.**

Notes:

- 1) All classifications in the best eye with best correction.
- 2) Glasses or contact lens to be worn for the classification test, if they are usually worn when shooting.
- 3) Archery classifications are different to ALL other sporting classifications for the vision impaired archer, ie: Archery is based on your acuity.
- 4) This classification is valid for 3 years, unless you are permanently B1.
