

SWFA Electronic Scoring Installation Guide

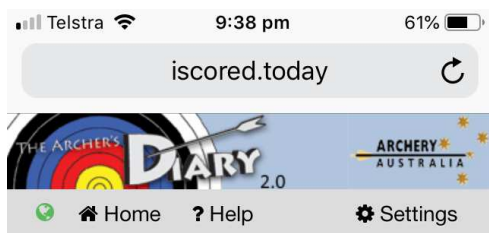
Use the following information to help install electronic scoring applications used at Shirewood Forest Archers.

Android devices:

- There is no phone app developed for android devices, but scores can be recorded via a web browser and using the following link:
 - o <http://iscored.today/#/>

iPhone/Apple devices:

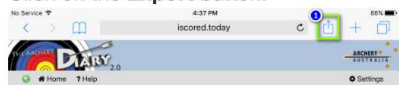
- Please note, this Apple application cannot be installed via the App Store...
- To install the iScored.today on your apple device, use the following steps:
 - o Ensure that you have web access
 - o Start Safari
 - o Open the following web page: iScored.today – and follow the steps:



For iOS devices, you must open **iScored.today** in **Safari**, it must be installed to the **Home Screen**, and launched from the Home Screen icon.

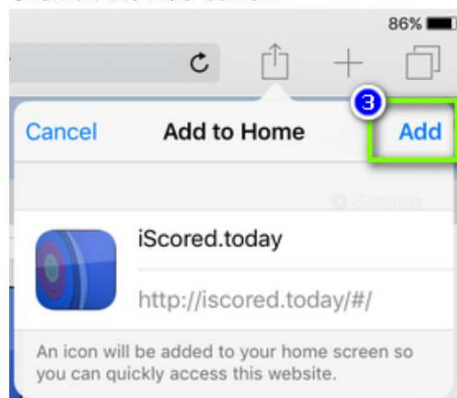
Step 1

Click on the **Export** button.



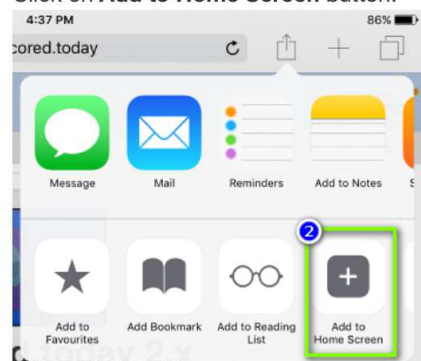
Step 3

Click on the **Add** button.



Step 2

Click on **Add to Home Screen** button.



Step 4

Close this window and launch the application from the new Home Screen icon.

Special Notes:

- New members are not automatically processed into Archers Diary and may take a few days to setup – if you do not see your name/number in Archers Diary or iScore.today app, then please send a descriptive email to: swfa@outlook.com
- Please remember that you will not see an event to record scores until the day of the event
- Registration for an event can happen at any time before the event (after the event has been created in Archers Diary) – but as soon as someone has allocated an archer to a target, then no further registrations on that event will be allowed.
- Registration, archer allocations and scoring require web access (mobile data on).
- Apple devices using the iScored.today app do not require web access during the scoring process, but will need it to finalised the scoring and update the scores back to Archers Diary.
- The iScored.today app and website are designed for recording scores into the Archer's Diary website. Your scores can be accessed after an event and for previous events via the following website:
