MANDATORY AND ENFORCEABLE CODES OF CONDUCT FOR COACHES, PLAYERS, MEMBERS, SUPPORTERS, AND OFFICIALS.

The Scoresby Football Club fully supports the codes of conduct as introduced by the AFL, AFL Victoria & the Eastern Football League (EFL)

COACH'S CODE OF CONDUCT

Coaches are required to sign the AFL Code of Conduct as part of the Level 1 Accreditation requirement. All coaches must be accredited to coach in our League.

PLAYER'S CODE OF CONDUCT

- Play by the rules – the rules of your club and the laws of the game.
- Never argue with an umpire or other official – without these people, you wouldn't be able to play the game
- Control your temper - verbal abuse of officials and sledging other players does not help you enjoy or win games.
- Be a team player – It is a team game, treat it that way.
- Treat all players, as you would like to be treated – fairly.
- Co-operate with your coach, the umpires and teammates.
- Play for your own enjoyment & to improve your skills.
- Do not use ugly remarks based on race, religion, gender or ability – you'll let down your coach, team-mates and family if you do – & many such comments are actually now illegal.

OFFICIAL'S, MEMBER'S & SUPPORTER'S CODE OF CONDUCT

- Remember that you are there for the participants to enjoy the game.
- Encourage participation, but don't force it.
- Teach that enjoyment is more important than winning.
- Never ridicule mistakes or losses – supporters are there to support not downgrade.
- Lead by example, respect all players, coaches, officials and spectators – physical and / or verbal abuse will not be tolerated.
- Recognise all volunteers who are giving up their valuable time.
- Never publicly criticise umpires – raise personal concerns with club officials in private.
- Do not use ugly remarks based on race, religion, gender or ability – you'll let down your family and yourself if you do – and many such comments are actually now illegal.

By becoming a member of Scoresby FC I agree to abide by these principles. I support the Club in its undertakings and encourage the Club to take any / all necessary disciplinary actions including the suspension and banning where warranted of any players, officials, members and / or spectators for repeated or serious breaches of these Codes of Conduct or other Club Policies.
