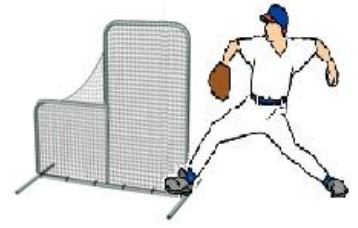


Batting Cage Rules

<p>An authorised member of the Concord Baseball Club must be present when the cage is in use.</p>	
<p>Batters MUST wear helmets at all times. No exceptions.</p>	
<p>Only <u>ONE</u> person per lane in batting cages at a time during play when using machines.</p> <p>A maximum of <u>TWO</u> persons allowed in the lane when using a live pitcher and batter.</p> <p>A maximum of <u>THREE</u> persons allowed in the lane when using a live pitcher and catcher with batter.</p> <p>Any other training drills must be under the direct supervision of a qualified Concord coach.</p>	   

Live pitcher must throw from behind a “L” screen and wear a helmet or skull cap no exceptions.



Catchers may only catch when using a live pitcher and must wear full protective equipment (no catching when using a pitching machine)



Anyone entering the cages must wear enclosed shoes.

No baseball-softball cleats or studs of any kind on any area of synthetic turf.



No Smoking



No Food, drink or gum to be brought or consumed inside the cages or on synthetic turf.



No person under the influence of drugs or alcohol is permitted to use the batting cages.



Children under the age of 14 must be under the supervision of a responsible adult.



Switch off the IRON MIKE™ machine before reloading or changing batters.



Switch off machine before re-loading

Players must be 14 years or older to reload machine. No one should remain in the vicinity of the IRON MIKE while its in use.



Only adults (18 years or older) may feed or remain in the vicinity of the “JUGS” pitching machine while it’s in operation.



No switch hitting during play.



Roller doors should be open while shed is in use.





Injuries could result from the use of the batting lanes. Users should assume the inherent risks of batting baseballs and dimple balls. The Concord Baseball Club accepts no responsibility for injury to any person using this facility.

If users have any questions about the use of the batting lanes or the inherent risks associated with the use of batting lanes, ask the authorised attendant before using the batting lanes.

Alert the attendant immediately if balls are throwing out of strike zone. Do not attempt to adjust the machines.

Balls may be pitched at any time. BE ALERT at all times.

No practice swings outside of cage.

The use of two piece bats and timber bats (especially when using the JUGS machine) is not recommended. The Concord Baseball Club accepts no responsibility for damage to bats or any other equipment brought into the facility by any person using this facility.
