- Proactively identify hazards and unsafe behaviours and take all steps to manage these to as low as reasonably practicable.
- When required (as defined in the Health and Safety at Work Act 2015) contribute to health and safety matters.
- Encourage their colleagues to participation in hazard identification and control.
- Demonstrate a commitment to achieving excellence in health and safety performance.
- Consult with the Local Organising Committee (LOC) Health and Safety representative to ensure they have the training, skills, knowledge, systems and resources to maintain a healthy and safe environment.
- Accurately report and record incidents and investigations including near misses that occur in your event or area and learn from these incidents.
- Comply with relevant legislation, regulations, event procedures and instruction from the LOC.
