# NSWACT Alpine Fitness and Conditioning Programs - 2012



During the April school holidays NSW Alpine and the National Alpine Committee organised a 3 day residential fitness testing and conditioning camp for all Child and FIS Alpine racers. The camp was held at the Sydney Academy of Sport at Narrabeen. About 30 participants attended the highly successful camp which was run by Manfred Wolscher and Sami Kennedy and Tom Dilba along with special guest presentations by Ferry Lee, NSWIS sports

psychologist and John Marsden NSWIS Strength and Conditioning Coordinator. Following on from these camps, weekly fitness training sessions have been held during Term 2 leading into the coming season. The Sydney sessions were conducted by Heidi Ainge and the Jindabyne sessions by Manuela Berchtold. The coaches were very impressed with participant's enthusiasm and efforts and report good progress by those attending the weekly sessions. The camp and weekly sessions were subsidized by NSW Alpine, NAC, TSRC and a grant from the NSW Govt Dept of Sport and Rec.







#### Alpine Rising Stars Program -2012



Based on the continued success of this program, NSWACT Alpine, Perisher Winter Sports Club and Thredbo Ski Racing Club are again combining to offer this exciting Award to talented Interschool racers without previous race club experience. 8 Alpine racers from Division 3, 4 or 5 across the Sydney, Northern or Southern/ACT regions will be selected for this year's Alpine Rising Stars Awards which offer the successful racers:

- a weekend of free training with Perisher or Thredbo Race Club
- free entry into the Blue Cow Cup Children's races

The Awards aim to encourage talented Interschool Alpine racers to experience the next level of Alpine skiing and racing. Successful racers will be notified of their selection after the Regional Interschool events. Previous winners are not eligible to win the award again this year.

# Alpine Skiing Level 1 Officials' Course
