Issue #112 (January 2017): Key “Shooting Form” + Equipment Articles

“Best Foot Forward” – get your stance right/correct - Duncan Busby

- Good stance is the “foundation” of any archer’s shoot & form
- Most beginner’s start with a square or neutral stance (feet parallel to the target, but most end up with “open stances” (feet turned slightly inward)
- If sight wandering left or right on the “gold” at full draw, your stance may need adjusting
- Starting in neutral stance, draw & close eyes for 3-4 seconds – then adjust your stance accordingly to draw & be on “gold” 100% of times

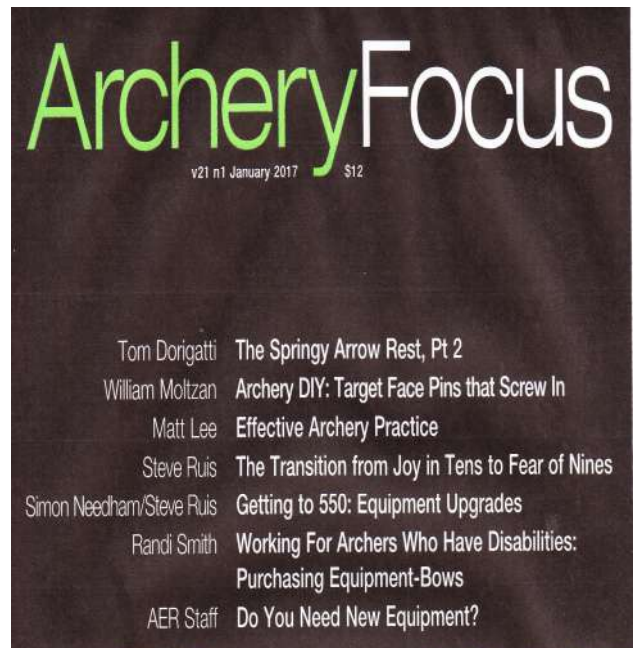
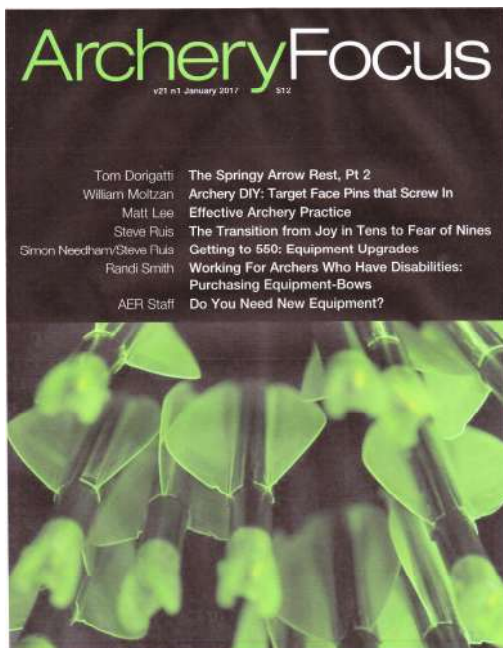

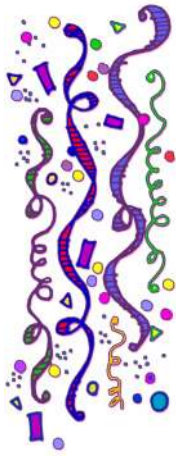
