We often get asked the status of results and records. The status is:

No FINA World Records or World Masters Games Records can be set at the Australian Masters Games. Masters Swimming Australia National Records are accepted. Once the records are accepted by the National Recorder the results of the Masters Games will be reclassified as a Time Trial as none of these swims can be used for FINA World Top 10 as FINA Masters does not recognise swims from non-MSA events or any Masters Games.
