WCSA INDOOR ROUNDS

1. WCSA 18m 600 Round (TC600 /25)
60 competition bolts from 18m using:
 - Triple Triangular 25cm face
 - Triple Vertical 25cm face (preferred)

2. WCSA 18m 600 Round (TC600 /40)
60 competition bolts from 18m using:
 - Triple Triangular 40cm face
 - Triple Vertical 40cm face (preferred)

ARCHERY AUSTRALIA/FITA ROUNDS

1. **FITA Indoor Rounds**
FITA 18m - 60 competition bolts from 18m - 40cm face no inner ten ring.
FITA 25m - 60 competition bolts from 25m - 60cm face no inner ten ring.
2. **AA Indoor Rounds**
AUS 1 - 30 competition bolts from 18m - 40cm face no inner ten ring.
AUS 2 - 30 competition bolts from 25m - 60cm face no inner ten ring.
Notes:
 - The full size ten ring shall be used for all Crossbow events.
 - Arbalests may elect to shoot either a full size 10 ring face, or a Triple Triangle face configuration.

3. Clout Rounds
